The academic gowns are to be returned in good condition immediately after the Convocation Ceremony. Any delay in return of the academic gown shall attract a fine of Five Hundred Naira (\frac{14500}{14500}) per day after, after Friday 8th March, 2024. Graduands are to further note that the issuance of the NCE certificate is also subject to the return of the gown in good condition to the Student Affairs Department.

- (ii) Each Graduand is entitled to the academic gown in addition to two invitation cards and the College Scroll. The invitation cards and scroll are available for collection at the Student Affairs Department and Records Division of the Registry respectively, from Monday 4th March, 2024 between 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. daily. The Convocation brochure is also available for purchase at the Statistics, Records and Scholarship Division of the Registry.
- (iii) Graduands should assemble at the Aduke Maina Hall not later than 8.00 a.m. on Thursday 7th March 2024, fully robed and seated in the place allocated to them by 9.00 a.m.
